## Death in hospitals

The statement of death in hospitals, nursing homes, institutes, colleges or any other plant, is transmitted to the Registry Office by the Director of the medical facilities (or his delegate) within 24 hours.

## Death in houses, public spaces, public roads

The statement of death in houses is made within 24 hours by a person informed of the death (usually, on behalf of the relatives ,a firm of undertakers will take care of the funeral rites ).

## Procedure

The registrar, after examining the documents (statement or notice of death, certificate issued by the doctor necropsy), will draw up the death certificate and issue authorization for burial

The burial can take place after :

- 24 hours in case of ordinary death,
- 48 hours in case of sudden death.

If death is due to violent causes, you need the Court authorisation for the burial.
